Reporting to the Program Manager, this position is responsible for meeting the dietary needs of Marymound's Ahsanook Program. Reflecting the heritage of the children and youth in its care, the program will maintain a focus on Aboriginal culture and traditions. Knowledge of and comfort with the traditions of Manitoba's First Nations and Métis populations are vital to this position.

The primary responsibilities of the position include but are not limited to:

- Menu planning for residential meals
- Fills group meal orders
- Orders, verifies and unpacks deliveries of food and supplies as needed
- Completes food preparation tasks such as cooking, baking, etc.
- Routine and task specific cleaning
- Participates in outdoor organized events as required (BBQs, etc.)

Qualifications:

- Basic knowledge of catering procedures
- Current Food Handler's Certificate
- General understanding of nutritional needs according to the current Canada Food Guide
- Knowledge of First Nations traditional foods and feasts
- Knowledge of First Nation teachings and customary practices
- Minimum six months experience in quantity cooking
- Knowledge of Aboriginal culture and traditions with connection to Aboriginal community
- Fluency in Manitoba First Nation language an asset
- Good organizational skills
- Ability to take initiative
- Good interpersonal communication skills
- Basic computer skills would be an asset
- Must be able to take direction and work well as part of a team
- Satisfactory criminal record check and clear child abuse registry with prior contact check
